Senior Residential Communities

Levels of care for those with Dementia

Assisted Living

Housing for elderly or disabled people that provides nursing care, housekeeping, and prepared meals as needed.

Memory Care

A distinct form of long-term care designed to meet the specific needs of a person with Alzheimer's disease, dementia or other types of memory problems.

Skilled Nursing

An in-patient rehabilitation center staffed with trained medical professionals.

Supportive Living

A community designed for individuals with disabilities and their families, to attain or retain their independence or interdependence.
